Tips for Trick-or-Treaters

1. Do not go inside anyone's house. Remain on stoop or porch.
2. Do not go into a stranger's automobile.
3. Never trick-or-treat alone. Go with at least two friends.
4. Look in all directions before crossing the streets.
5. Walk on sidewalks, never the street.

Parent Tips

1. An adult should always accompany young children.
2. Keep pumpkins with lit candles away from doorsteps where costumes can catch fire. Commercially available battery lights are much safer.
3. Drive carefully and watch for excited youngsters darting into the streets.
4. Parents should never let their children carve a pumpkin unsupervised.
5. Inspect candy before it is eaten. When in doubt, throw it out.

Costumes Tips

1. Only purchase and use flame retardant costumes.
2. Costumes should fit properly avoid loose or baggy costumes.
3. Encourage children to wear face paint oppose to a mask
4. Children should never carry sharp objects.
5. Use reflective markings or tape on costumes.
